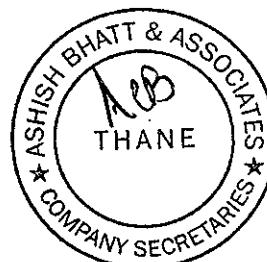


SCRUTINIZER'S REPORT

1. The Board of Directors of the Company has passed the resolution on June 11, 2016 for appointing me as a Scrutinizer for conducting the postal ballot voting process.
2. I submit my report as under:
 - 2.1 The Company has completed on June 25, 2016 the dispatch of postal ballot forms along with postage prepaid business reply envelope to its Members whose name(s) appeared in the Register of Members/list of beneficiaries as on June 10, 2016. The company has also made arrangement for e-voting with CDSL.
 - 2.2 Particulars of all the postal ballot and e-voting forms received from the Members have been entered in a register separately maintained for the purpose.
 - 2.3 The postal ballot forms were kept under, my safe custody in sealed and tamper proof ballot boxes before commencing the scrutiny of such postal ballot forms.
 - 2.4 The ballot boxes were opened on July 27, 2016 in my presence.
 - 2.5 The postal ballot forms were duly opened in my presence and scrutinized and the shareholding was matched/ confirmed with the Register of Members of the Company/ list of beneficiaries as on June 10, 2016.
 - 2.6 All postal ballot forms received up to 05.00 p.m. on July 27, 2016, the last date and time fixed by the Company for receipt of the forms, were considered for my scrutiny.
 - 2.7 Envelopes containing postal ballot forms received after July 27, 2016, were not considered for my scrutiny.



2.8 Envelopes containing postal ballot forms returned undelivered aggregated to 62 vide serial number 1 to 62. These envelopes were also not opened and they are separately kept.

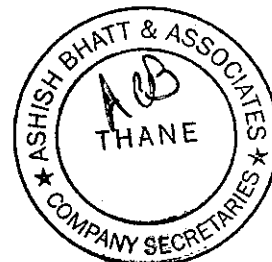
2.9 I did not find any defaced or mutilated ballot paper.
